


The Ellis Kadoorie School was founded in 1891 by Mr (later Sir) Ellis Kadoorie, a member of a Jewish family in Baghdad. Our school was first called Yucai Shushe 育才書社 and established at a site in Sai Ying Pun through the generosity of the Kadoorie Family in 1890s.

In 1915, the Hong Kong Government assumed management of the school and new school premises were established. At a cost of 35 thousand Hong Kong dollars, seats for 160 boys were set up, mainly for educating Indian children.





The Ellis Kadoorie School for Indians at Sookunpo was opened on 17th October, 1916, by His Excellency the Governor, Sir Francis Henry May. During the opening ceremony, the Governor presented a speech which mentioned the previous condition of Indian students in Hong Kong. Chinese and European boys were admitted to the school as well by this time, as one can see in the photo above.



Mr Ellis Kadoorie was knighted in 1917. Since then, the school has the name 'Sir Ellis Kadoorie School, Sookunpo', to distinguish it from the school in Sai Ying Pun.


While the medium of instruction was English, interestingly, it was the first school in Hong Kong where Hindi and Urdu languages were included in the school curriculum.



After the 2nd World War, the damage to Sir Ellis Kadoorie School was repaired and a new extension was added. It was re-opened in 1946 with A.M. (English) and P.M. (Chinese) sessions.

In the 1950s, the school conducted Primary classes only. It was expanded to Form One and later to Form Five in 1978. The P.M. session was closed in 1975 and the school commenced operating as a whole-day school.



In 1980-81, Sir Ellis Kadoorie School was re-organised into a Primary and a Secondary school but both still shared the same school premises.



Due to the increased demand for places in both the Primary and the Secondary section, the decision was made for the Secondary school to be moved to West Kowloon in 1999. Since then the Sookunpo school premises have been solely a primary school.

The School Management Committee of Sir Ellis Kadoorie (S) Primary School was set up in the same academic year (1999). It consists of an officer appointed by the Education Bureau, School Head, two teacher representatives, two parent representatives, two alumni representatives and two independent members. Under the supervision of this committee, the school is well managed, administrated and operated.



In 1970, the Chinese Language was introduced to the school curriculum but it was phased out in the 1980s. Then due to the return of sovereignty in 1997, Chinese was reintroduced as a core subject in the school year of 1999/2000. From then on, the school has been striving hard to aim at maintaining a balanced curriculum with emphasis on enhancing both the English and Chinese languages.


Reflecting on the changing demands of the modern world, the school progresses courageously on the great journey in the new era, especially under the tough pandemic period.




