A reported case of SEKPS parent having positive R.A.T. result (July 22, 2022)

We were notified by a parent of P2 today that s/he was tested positive with R.A.T. while the student was tested negative. The parent attended the prize-giving ceremony yesterday (21/7). The last day this student attended school was also July 21, 2022 (Thursday) and s/he has no siblings studying in our school. The school has already put forward the follow-up measures immediately:

1. Cleaned and sanitized the hall, classrooms and washrooms thoroughly.
2. Reminded teachers, students and staff who had close contact with the student to take note of their health conditions.
3. Reported the case to EDB.

We will have close contact with the CHP, and follow up with the health conditions of all teachers, staff and students. Parents are reminded to undergo R.A.T. for their child and upload the result to eClass before coming to school every day. Parents should not bring their child to school if the R.A.T. has shown to be positive.
