A reported case of SEKPS student having infected COVID-19 (2nd August, 2022)


We were notified by a parent today that a 4C student has been infected with COVID-19. The last day the student attended school was July 25, 2022 (Monday) and s/he has no sibling studying in our school. The school has already put forward the follow-up measures immediately:

1. Reported the case to the Centre for Health Protection (CHP).
2. Cleaned and sanitized the respective classrooms, washrooms and railings on the stairs thoroughly.
3. Reminded teachers, students and staff who had close contact with the student to take note of their health conditions.

We will have close contact with the CHP, and follow up with the health conditions of all teachers, staff and students. Parents are reminded to undergo R.A.T. for their child and upload the result to eClass before coming to school every day. Parents should not bring their child to school if the R.A.T. has shown to be positive.
