Under the Hong Kong Childhood Immunisation Programme advised by Department of Health, P6 female students should receive the following vaccination for comprehensive protection against childhood infectious diseases. Details are as follows:

Date	: 5 th July 2021(Monday)
Venue	: School Hall
Time	: 10:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m.
Vaccination to be received	: 1. Human Papillomavirus Vaccine (HPV) 2. Hepatitis B Vaccine 3. Measles, Mumps and Rubella Vaccine (MMR) 4. Combined Diphtheria, Tetanus, acellular Pertussis (reduced dose) & Inactivated Poliovirus Vaccine (dTap-IPV Vaccine)

Centre for Health Protection(CHP) claims that students receiving multiple vaccinations in one single day is safe, yet our school would like parents to state the decision. Please complete the consent / refusal form to state whether your child will receive the vaccination. If you wish your child to receive Hepatitis B, MMR or HPV Vaccine on other days, you must complete the consent form. The staff of immunization team will arrange another timeslot for your child but parents have to bring him / her to the clinic on your own. All primary six students will receive any missing vaccinations again when they get promoted to Form 3 in the secondary schools.
